CURRICULUM VITAE LUCA PAGNAMENTA

Luca Pagnamenta was born in Lugano on 24 October 1956. After the primary schools attended in Lugano he continued his training and graduated as an Architect at the Higher technical School of architecture in Trevano. Then he continued to graduate courses in Geneva and then to New York University in New York; In 1997 he obtained the Federal Certificate of real estate administrator. Interested in Painting and Sculpture in 1998 he graduated from the Academy of fine Arts of Brera in Milan.

After a first two-year work experience at the studio Plojoux Architects in Geneva, in 1982 he became collaborator of the architect Bernard Tschumi in New York. With the Tschumi team, he took part in some international competitions, winning the first prize and the executive mandate of the "Parc de la Villette" in Paris, one of the "Grands Projets" commissioned by French President Mitterand to restore prestige to the "Ville Lumiere". From 1983 to 1987 he lived in Paris to follow the construction of this important project.

Returning to Ticino in 1989, for about ten years he joined his father Sergio in conducting his architectural studio. It He had the opportunity to follow and implement some important projects such as the Renovation of the historic "Casa Airoldi" on the lakefront of Lugano, Headquarter of the Arner Bank, a Residential building in Via Motta in Massagno, the construction of two Single-family houses in Sorengo, the Renovation and transformation of a Office building in Via Nassa 44 in Lugano then Bank Syz & Co, the building "Ca' Nova" in Canova Street in Lugano for the Torricelli family, the renovation of a vintage Villa in the district of Loreto, property Bernardino Bulla.

Since 1995 is registered to the order OTIA and member of the Swiss Register of Engineers and Architects (REG-B); he is currently President of ASIAT - Association of Engineering Studies and Architecture Ticinesi, and vice president of CAT - Conference of Technical Associations of Canton Ticino.

From 1999 he became the sole owner of his own architectural firm based in Via Bagutti in Lugano. He was in charge of the renovation of a historical country house of the Bonzanigo family in Cureglia and for the city of Lugano he realized the expansion of the Cemetery and the construction of the new Burial Chambers. In via Bossi in Lugano he carried out the realization of the headquarters of the LGT Bank - Liechtenstein, becomes consultant of TASIS (The American School in Switzerland) of Montagnola to follow the realization of the new buildings on the Campus, realizes the Villa Graf-Bressan to Agno-Bioggio and renovated two apartments at the residence Bristol in Via Maraini in Lugano.

Since 2011 he associated with architect Ugo Früh and developed together several projects, including the Renovation of the building in via Nassa 3 in Lugano, the Building for logistics of Bolliger e Tanzi in Caslano, the Residential Building on Via Cabione 2 in Massagno, the Residenza Licasa on via Sorengo in Lugano, the Residential building on via Collina d'oro in Montagnola, as well as numerous single family houses.
